

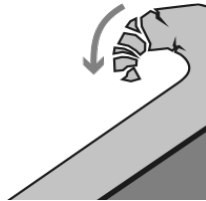

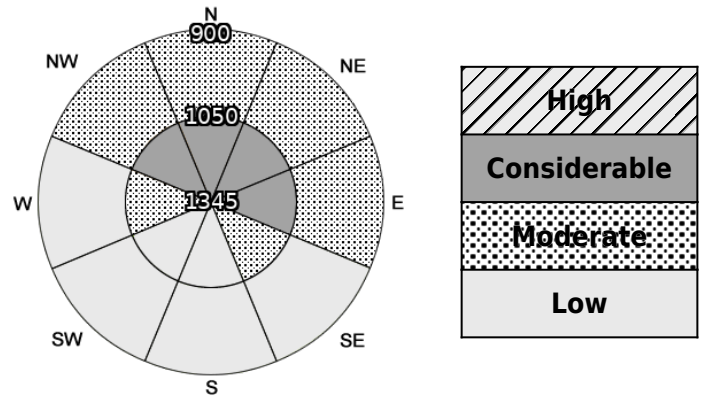
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further deposits of unstable windslab will add to existing accumulations mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 1050 metres. Below this height stability will be better. Some large and unstable cornices will remain above these aspects. Exposed windward aspects will generally be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force South-South-Westerly winds initially gradually ease through the period. Showers, heavy at times, will fall as snow above around 600 metres. The freezing level will drop to around 700 metres overnight, rising slightly in the afternoon.
