

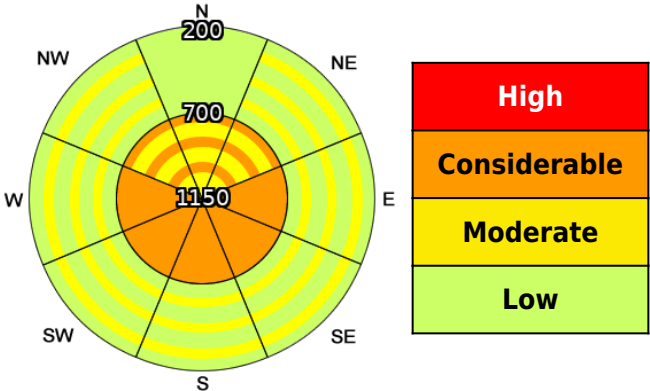

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 06/01/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Very weakly bonded windslab will exist in all sheltered gullies and hollows and also on slopes with an East through South to Westerly aspect mainly above 700 metres where Avalanches are likely and where deep windslab forms. Steep scarp slopes and sheltered gullies will be particularly affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with fresh North-North-East winds backing Northerly and decreasing slightly on Wednesday. Snow showers will be scattered or isolated.

Comments

Unstable windslab and cornice formations will require great caution and careful route planning. Ice is continuing to form on a good number of routes.
