

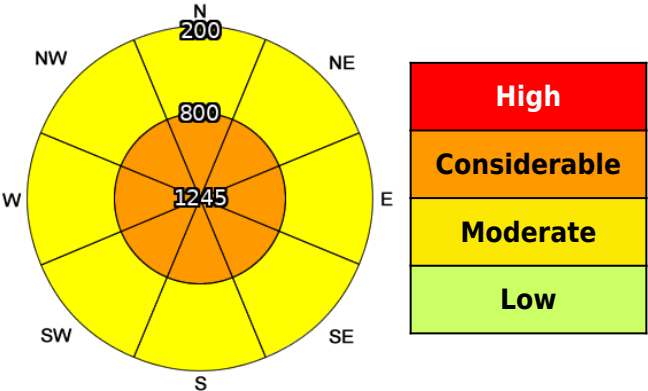

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

With the cold temperatures instabilities will continue to be present in the snowpack on all aspects above 800 metres. In particular, on East through South to Westerly aspects above 900 metres the snowpack is weakly bonded and avalanches are likely. Steeper slopes, Corrie rims, gully flanks and exits in North facing corries will be affected due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight some light snow showers with Northerly winds will occur. The day will be largely dry. calm and clear, with summit temperatures around minus 8 degrees celsius.

Difficult access to all areas by foot. Good route finding required.
