

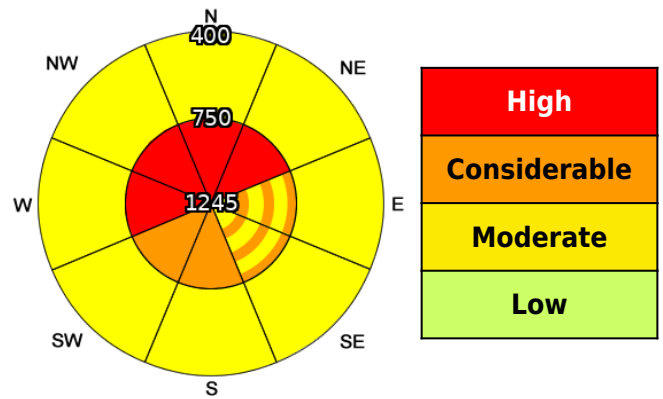

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 16/01/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

During the temperature rise there will be a period of high snowpack instabilities. Avalanches will occur on West through North to North-East aspects above 750 metres. New windslab accumulations will develop on North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight on Friday night there will be heavy rain with a freezing level of 1500 metres. This will be followed by sleet as the freezing level falls to 1100 metres during Saturday. The winds will be strong and from the South.
