

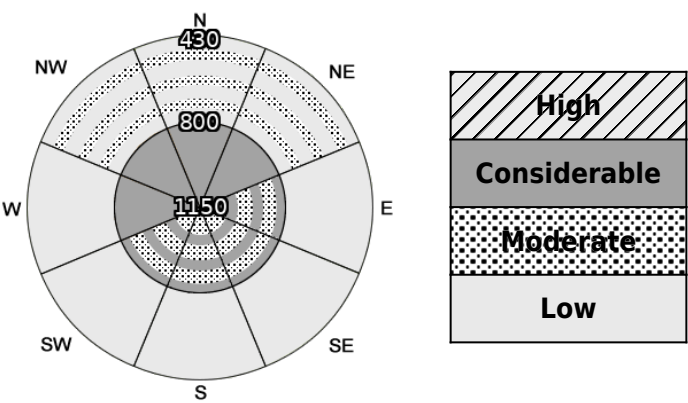

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow showers and the strong Southerly winds will continue to form new accumulations of unstable windslab in sheltered areas above 800 metres. North-West through to North-East slopes and sheltered gullies will be especially effected and will hold the deepest deposits of weakly bonded snow. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers on strong Southerly winds increasing in strength becoming South-Westerly. Freezing level around 800 metres.

Comments

A strong showery South-Westerly airflow will affect the area and winds could be gale force.
