

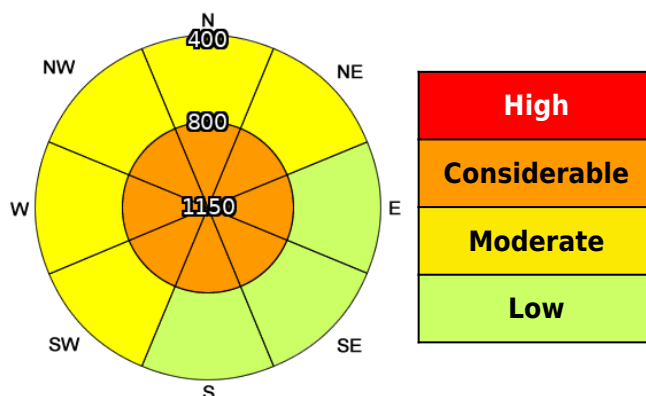

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 17/01/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Above 800 metres, on nearly all aspects, significant older and more recent weaknesses exist. New windslab has formed at higher elevations where avalanches are likely. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be some cooling and winds will become light to moderate, initially from the South then becoming South-West. There will be little or no precipitation.

Comments

The recent warm, wet storm has flushed out and stabilized things at lower elevations, but unstable windslab still remains higher up. This condition will be particularly prevalent near the tops of steep gullies.
