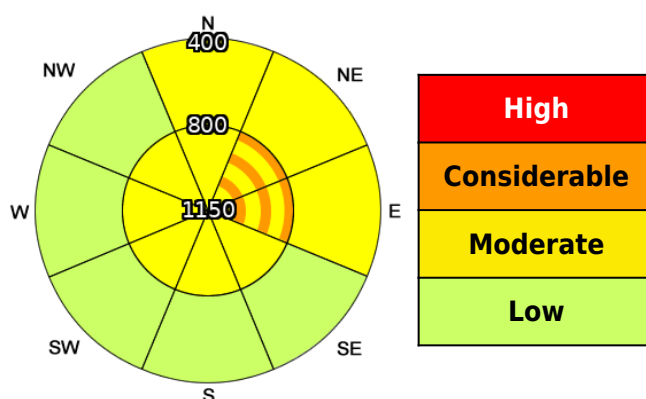


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 18/01/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The new snow will be moist and should bond quite well to the old snow surface. However, localized drifting could result in patches of windslab on steep North-East and East facing slopes where avalanches are likely above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Snow showers are forecast with strong South-West to Westerly winds. The freezing level will rise to around 1100 metres.

Comments

Patches of windslab high up on the exits of steep gullies. If the temperature stays colder than expected, this problem may become more widespread.
