



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 18/01/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting will lead to weakly bonded windslab developing in sheltered locations. Avalanches are likely on Northerly through East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Corrie rims, gully heads and crag aprons will be especially affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate snowfall is expected during Sunday evening. This will clear to leave a dry day. The winds will be strong South-West veering West and decreasing to moderate as the day progresses. The freezing level will fluctuate around 1000 metres.

Comments

Walking conditions greatly improved underfoot since the thaw freeze cycle.
