

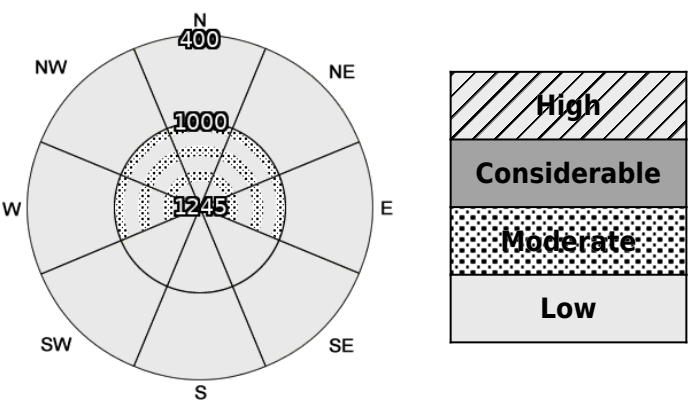

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to stabilise and will be generally well bonded and stable at all levels and on all aspects. Some isolated moderately bonded windslab will be present mainly above 1000 meters in sheltered hollows and corrie rims on West through North to Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a dry day with strong South-Easterly winds which will slowly ease in the day. The freezing level will be at 450 metres.

Comments

Remaining generally cold with strong winds for the next few days - blizzards Thursday.
