

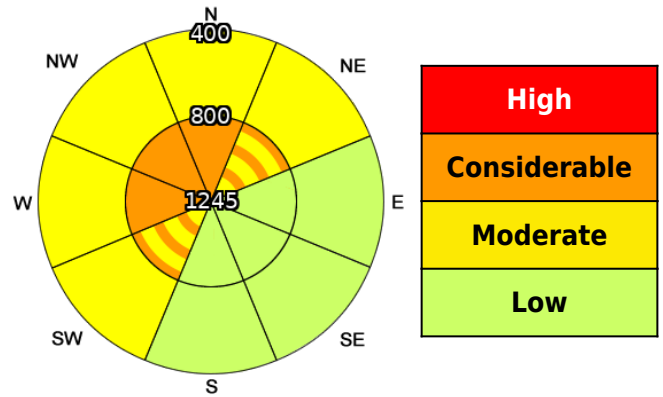

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Heavy drifting will continue to form unstable windslab on mainly West to Northerly aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Other aspects and levels will contain isolated unstable areas of windslab due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the wind will be moderate South-Easterly with some occasional snowfall. During the day the wind will strengthen but no precipitation is expected. The freezing level will be at 500 metres.

Comments

More snow to arrive during late thursday with blizzard conditions.
