



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 23/01/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New windslab accumulations will develop on South to West aspects above 900 metres. Instabilities will continue to affect North-West to North-East aspects above this altitude. Steep sheltered terrain such as corrie rims, crag aprons and gully exits will be particularly affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Friday evening will be mainly dry with light winds. On Saturday an increasing number of snow showers will develop on moderate North-East winds. The overnight 1000 metre freezing level will lower to around 600 metres during the day.

Comments

Conditions underfoot mostly firm on the old snow.
