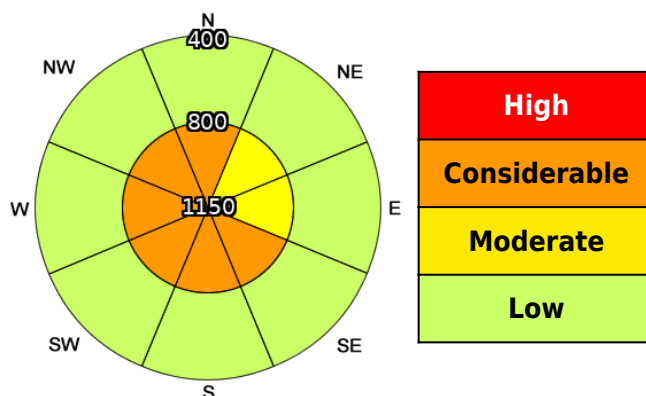


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 24/01/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Windslab will continue to develop on steep South-East through West to North aspects above 800 metres. Instabilities will also exist on West to North aspects. The snow at this level is cold and slowly consolidating but a deep seated weakness does exist in these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Light snowfall is forecast with moderate winds, initially from the North then becoming Easterly. The summit temperatures will fall to around -4C on the summits during Sunday.

Comments

In white-out conditions, keep in mind that it is easy to stray onto a steep, wind-loaded slopes without realising it.
