

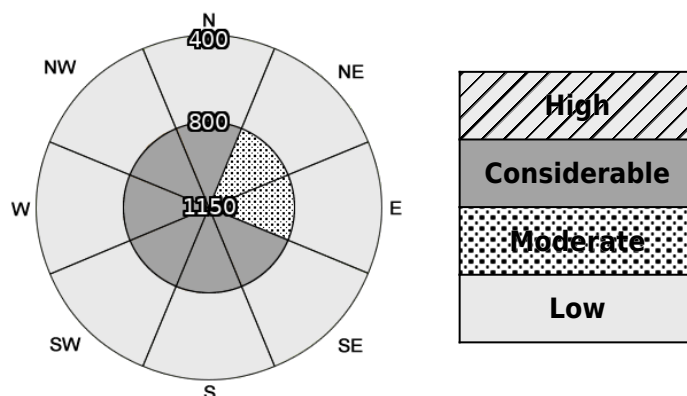

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 24/01/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Windslab will continue to develop on steep South-East through West to North aspects above 800 metres. Instabilities will also exist on West to North aspects. The snow at this level is cold and slowly consolidating but a deep seated weakness does exist in these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snowfall is forecast with moderate winds, initially from the North then becoming Easterly. The summit temperatures will fall to around -4C on the summits during Sunday.

Comments

In white-out conditions, keep in mind that it is easy to stray onto a steep, wind-loaded slopes without realising it.
