

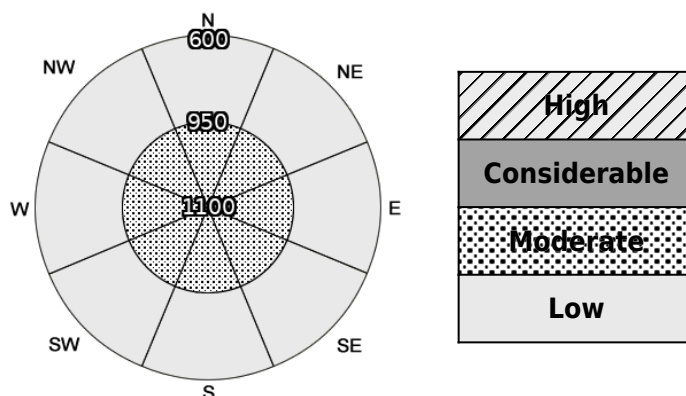

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 25/01/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snow may continue to drift on to steep South-West to North-facing slopes and gully tops above 950m. Some thin but weakly-stabilised windslab development is possible in these places but stability will improve in other locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will die out as high pressure builds. It will remain cold and winds will be light to moderate Easterly, later South-East.

Comments

Misty but bright and warmer for a time on Sunday. Monday looking good but much milder weather with rain likely on Tuesday.
