

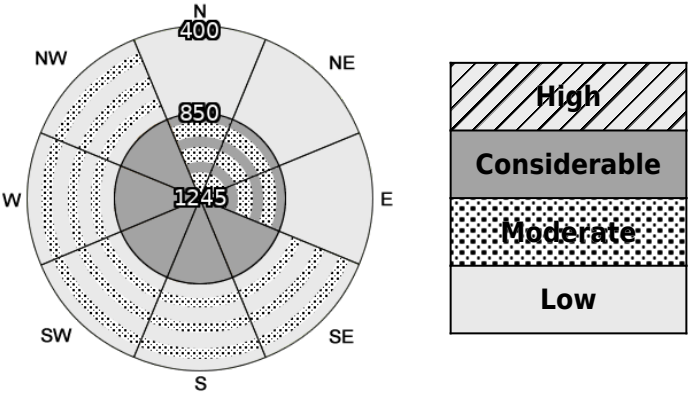

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will remain within the recently deposited windslab. Above 850 metres steep South-East through West to North-West aspects will be particularly affected. Localised deposits are also lying on North to East facing slopes especially in sheltered areas such as scarp slopes, gully tops, crag aprons and corrie rims. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow flurries overnight will die out to leave a dry day. The winds will be light to moderate East veering South-Easterly and the freezing level will be around 350 metres.
