



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will begin to refreeze above 600 metres and will be generally stable on most aspects. During the day new snow accumulations will form localised unstable windslab on mainly East to Southerly aspects above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong West winds and rain are expected overnight with a freezing level at 2000 metres. During the day the freezing level will fall to 900 metres, the wind will be strong North-Westerly with snow showers.
