

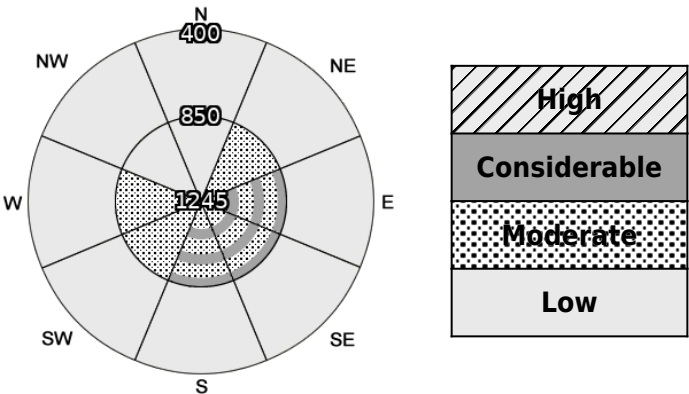

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and stabilise at all levels and on most aspects. Some new accumulations of snow will form unstable windslab on mainly East to South aspects above 850 metres, but localised accumulations will form in sheltered locations on North-East and West aspects due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day the winds will be strong North-Westerly with some snow. The freezing level will be at 500 metres during the day.
