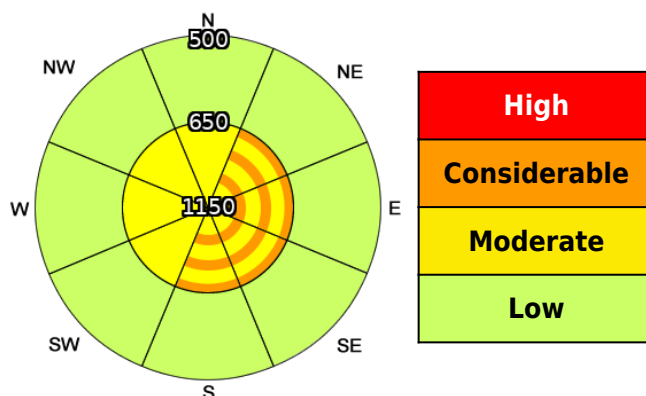


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 28/01/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The colder temperatures will stabilise the existing snowpack further which will become generally well bonded and stable on most aspects. The new snow accumulations will form unstable windslab on mainly North- East to South aspects above 650 metres with additional localised instabilities on gully exits and corrie rims. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be low temperatures with light flurries of snow. The snow showers will increase later with the strong North-Westerly winds.

Comments

Exposed old snow will be frozen by tomorrow and will be firm and icy.
