



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderately bonded windslab will be present and developing in sheltered locations, mainly on South-East through to South-West aspects above 800 metres especially where deep accumulations exist on steeper slopes. Localised pockets of windslab will also be present on other sheltered aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with overnight snow showers becoming less frequent during the day with strong Northerly winds. Summit temperatures around minus 6 celsuis.

Comments

Cold Northerly airstream, winds strong and gusts of 45 mph. Saturday will be mostly dry but the strong winds will continue the windslab development in sheltered areas.
