

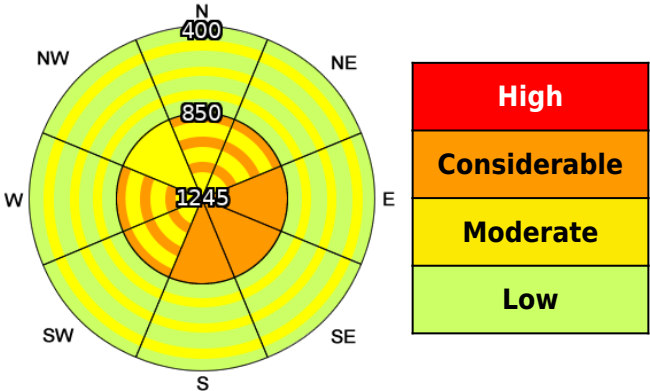

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be heavy drifting and accumulations of weakly bonded windslab will continue to develop. Avalanches are likely on Easterly to Southerly aspects above 850 metres. Due to cross loading localised deposits will also affect other aspects particularly in sheltered locations such as gully flanks and crag aprons. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain very cold with frequent snow showers on strong North-West winds.

Cornices will be weak on E to S aspects.
