

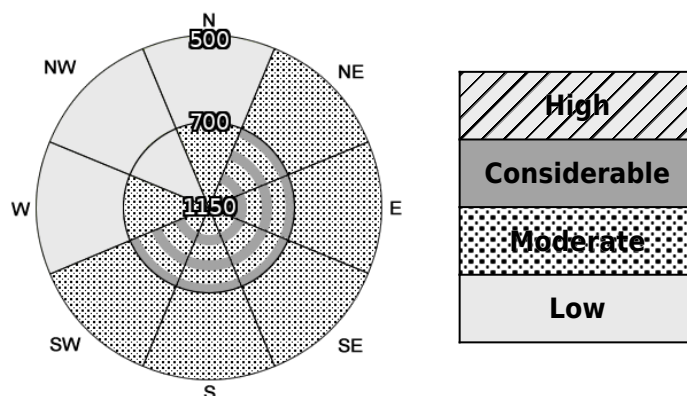

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There is overall strengthening of the deeper snowpack, however the unstable surface wind slab is likely to avalanche on steep, convex terrain. The hazard will be mainly on scarp slopes and gully exits from North-East through South to South-West aspects above 700 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be very light snow showers with a slight rise in temperature but still remaining below freezing above 500 metres. Winds will moderate and change from North-West to South-West.
