

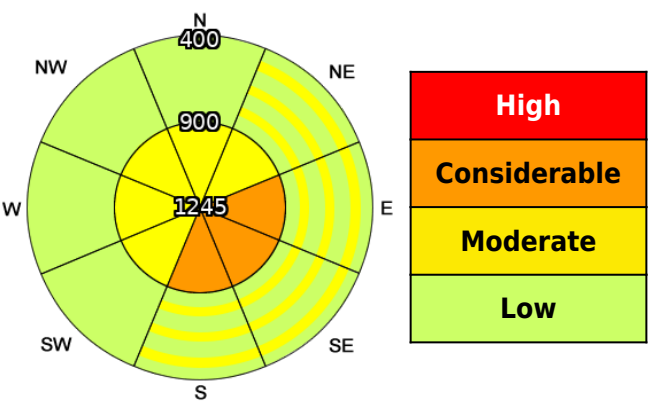

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of weakly bonded windslab will be present on mainly Easterly to Southerly aspects above 900 metres. On all other aspects isolated accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will be present on steep terrain, especially gully flanks and exits in North facing corries due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be light variable overnight then light North-North -Westerly with snow showers during the day. The freezing level will be at 400 metres overnight and at all levels during the day.
