


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 02/02/2010**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Weakly bonded windslab will be present mainly on sheltered North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Avalanches are likely on steep slopes and in gullies where significant deposits exist. Areas of localised windslab will also be present on other aspects due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable. New cornices will be unstable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight snow showers with variable winds, freezing level will be around 800 metres. During the day light winds will be from the North and mainly dry with the freezing level lowering to 300 metres.

**Comments**

Caution is required on the approach to climbs.
