

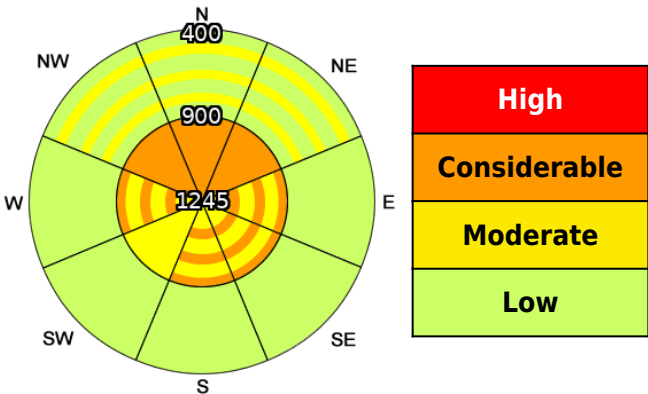
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 04/02/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will form on mainly North-West to North-Easterly aspects above 900m where avalanches are likely . Gully exits and corrie rims will be particularly affected. On other aspects isolated areas of unstable windslab will remain mainly above 950 meters on East to South aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the wind will be strong Southerly with light snow showers, during the day the wind will remain Southerly and strengthen with no precipitation expected. The freezing level will be at 600 metres.
