



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some snowpack consolidation will take place. Instabilities will continue to affect steep terrain mainly on Westerly to Northerly aspects above 950 metres with localised deposits elsewhere. Crag aprons, gully flanks, exits and corrie rims will be especially affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will fall from 800 to 600 metres during the day and overnight snow flurries will eventually die out. The winds will be moderate and from the East.

Comments

Large cornices in N Corries: Worth giving a very wide berth when hand railing Corrie rims especially in this poor visibility.
