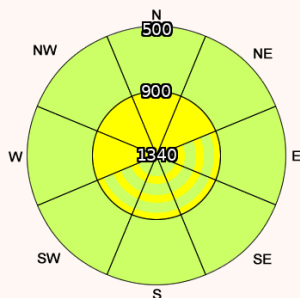


**Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Sun 07/02/2010 TO 18:00HRS Mon 08/02/2010**



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
<b>Very High</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
<b>High</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
<b>Considerable</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
<b>Moderate</b>	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
<b>Low</b>	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A dry day with moderate North-Easterly winds is expected. The freezing level will be around 500 metres.

**Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will continue to slowly consolidate and stability improve. However, areas of moderately bonded windslab will remain mainly on steep West through North to North-East aspects above 900 metres. At lower levels stability will generally be good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Observed Avalanche Hazard - Sun 07/02/2010**

**Observed Weather Influences**

It was dry overnight and through the day. Moderate winds were from the South-East. The freezing level was around 800 metres.

**Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard**

With the winds not being strong enough for significant snowpack re-deposition, and the temperatures below freezing at high levels, little change was observed in the snowpack. It continues to slowly consolidate. Areas of moderately bonded windslab exist on West through North to North-East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard is Moderate.

**Observed Mountain Travel Conditions**

Good cover above 800 metres.

**Comments**

A low visibility day on the tops on Sunday.
