

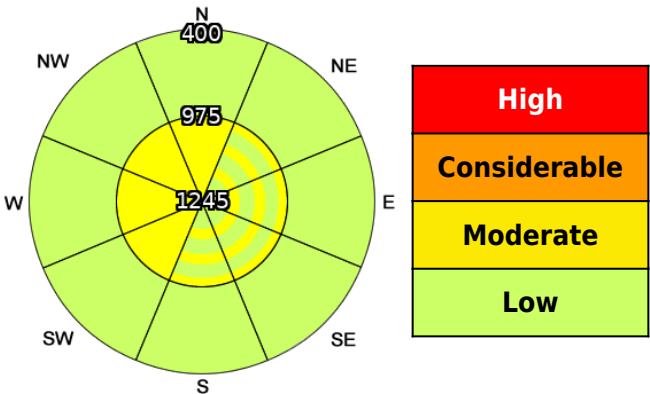

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 08/02/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old windslab which is lying mainly on Westerly to Northerly aspects above 975 metres will remain moderately well bonded. Localised new accumulations will lie in sheltered locations on Southerly through West to North-West aspects above this altitude. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be cold and a dry night will be followed by snow flurries which will increase as the day progresses. The winds will be light to Moderate East backing North-Easterlies.
