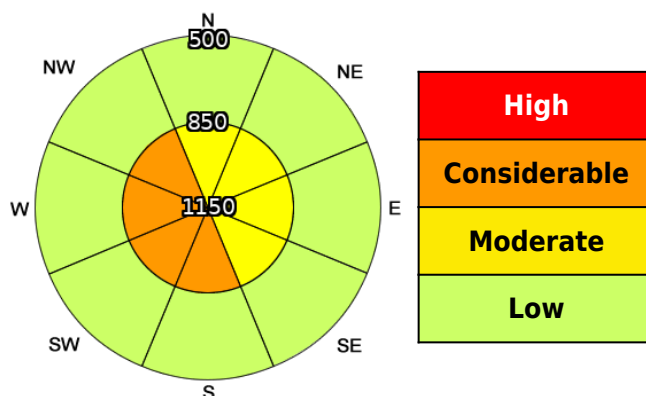


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 09/02/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Areas of poorly bonded wind slab will be mainly on South through South-West to North-West aspects above 850 metres where avalanches are likely. The deeper snowpack will continue to be strong in the continued cold temperatures. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Temperatures will remain cool in the developing Arctic ridge, weather situation. Winds will continue from the North-East changing to Northerly in the day with snow showers.

Comments

The avalanche reported this afternoon is a reminder that avalanche activity is still a very real possibility, even with cooling and very little new snow. It's a big winter and nearly half over. Take care.
