

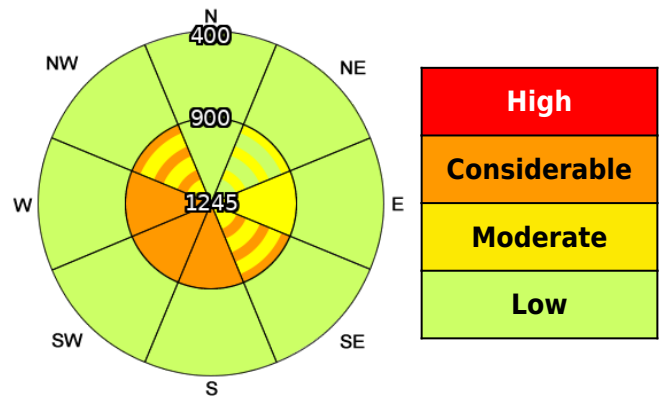

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will form on mainly South to Westerly aspects above 900 metres, adding to the existing, weakly bonded windslab located on West aspects at 1000 metres. Isolated windslab deposits will also form in sheltered, localised areas on other aspects due to cross loading. Elsewhere the snowpack is generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the wind will be moderate North-Westerly with some snow, during the day the wind will become North-Easterly with snow showers. The freezing level will be at 300 metres.

Comments

Good climbing conditions with some pockets of new snow.
