

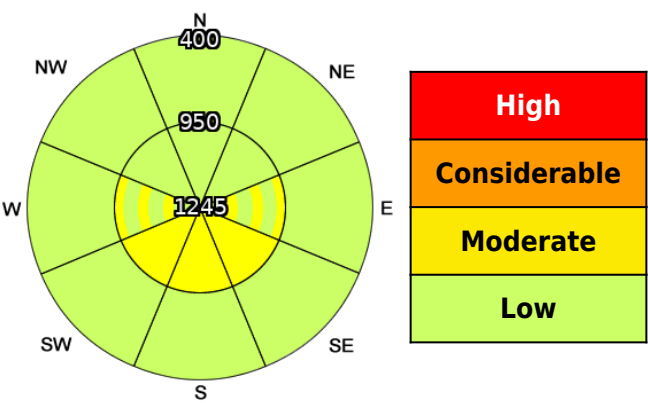

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 11/02/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to stabilise and consolidate and will be generally well bonded and stable on all aspects and altitudes. Weaknesses will persist in the windslab deposits in sheltered and isolated locations such as steep slopes, hollows and corrie rims mainly above 950 metres on South-East to South West aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the wind will be light North-Westerly becoming Northerly in the day with the possibility of occasional light snow showers. The freezing level will be at 600 metres.
