

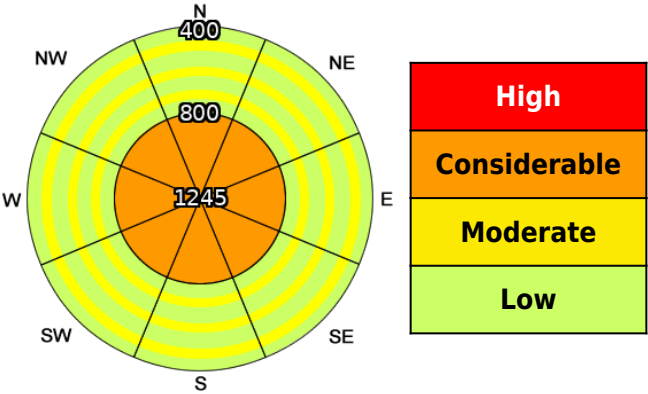
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow will lie on all aspects and snowpack instabilities will become more prominent during the temperature rise. Avalanches are likely in areas of steep terrain on all aspects above 800 metres. East through South to South-West aspects will be particularly affected. Cornices will become unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The winds will be light and from the South-West and light snow showers on Saturday night will become heavier on Sunday. The freezing level will gradually rise to 1000 metres during the day.
