

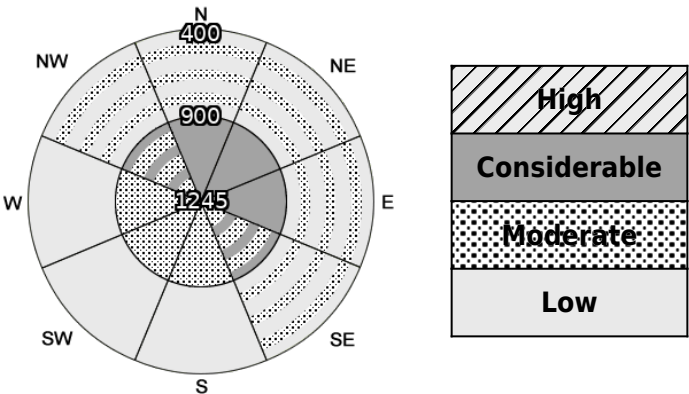

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 15/02/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some drifting will take place at higher altitudes and new windslab accumulations will develop. Avalanches are likely on steep Northerly to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Cross loading will also affect sheltered locations on other aspects especially in gullies and on Crag aprons. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snowfall overnight will become more persistent around dawn before turning to showers during the day. The winds will be moderate South-Westerlies and the freezing level will fall to 600 metres on Monday.
