

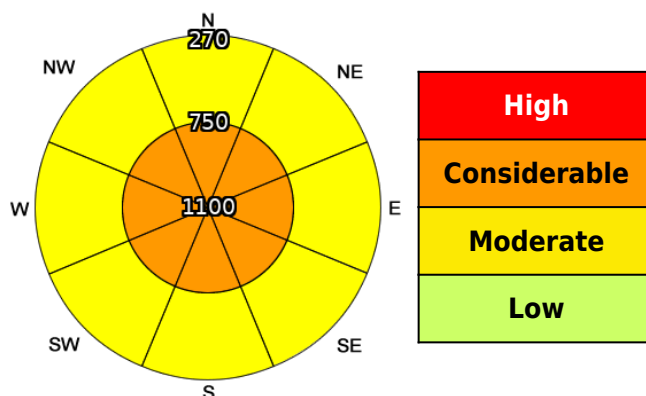
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 18/02/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instability is expected to remain widespread on slopes of all aspects above 750m and avalanches are likely. In the event of drifting, additional weak windslab will form on North-West through North to North-East aspects above 900m and stability will decline further. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A few light snow flurries are possible. It will remain cold with light to moderate South-East, later South-West winds.

Comments

Creag Meagaidh very quiet on Weds. Forecasted windspeed at a critical threshold, any higher and there will drifting and declining stability on lee slopes.
