



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 20/02/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Steep terrain, convexities and corrie rims will continue to be affected by localised instabilities on most aspects above 950 metres. New snow accumulations lying on the widespread surface hoar will further add to snowpack weaknesses. Below this level the snowpack will remain generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers are expected to die out during Friday evening, this will be followed by a mainly dry day. Winds will be light South-Westerlies and it will be freezing at all levels.

Comments

Existing surface hoar is impressive and widespread. Any new accumulations overlying this will lead to significant snowpack weaknesses.
