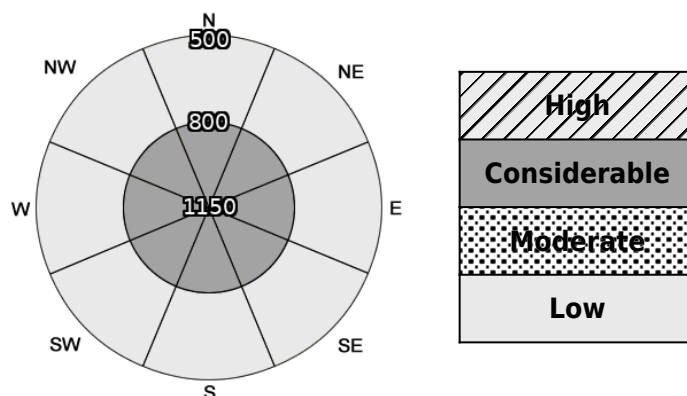

Although the winds have been quite light there are areas of weakly bonded slab on South-East to West aspects above 800 metres. The change in wind direction will see further slab build on North to East aspects also above 800 metres. Corrie rims and gully exits are where avalanches are most likely. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Although wind direction remains light to moderate there will be a significant change in direction from Northerly to the South-West. Light snow showers will ease and it will be mainly dry on Saturday. Temperatures will be very cold.
