

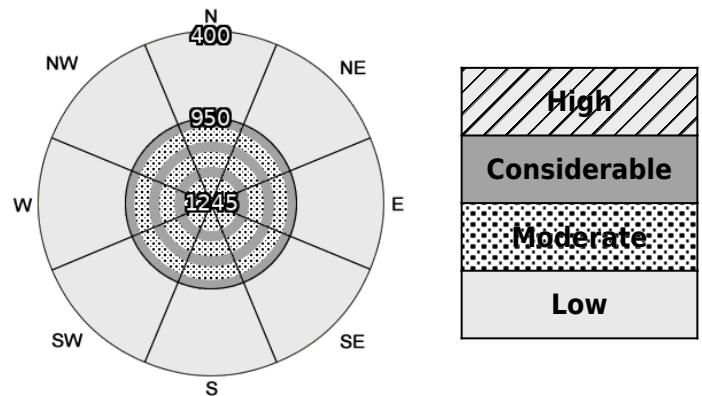

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 22/02/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Isolated pockets of instability will continue to affect most aspects above 950 metres. Areas mainly affected will be steep terrain such as scarp slopes, gully exits, convexities, and corrie rims. Localised new accumulations of weakly bonded windslab may develop on South through West to North-West aspects at higher altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be mostly dry with a possible light dusting of snow during the day. Cold temperatures will persist and the winds will be light to moderate East to North-Easterly.

Comments

Snowpack still very cold especially in shady areas leading to strong temperature gradients and facet growth. Cornices huge, especially over some of the Lochain crags.
