

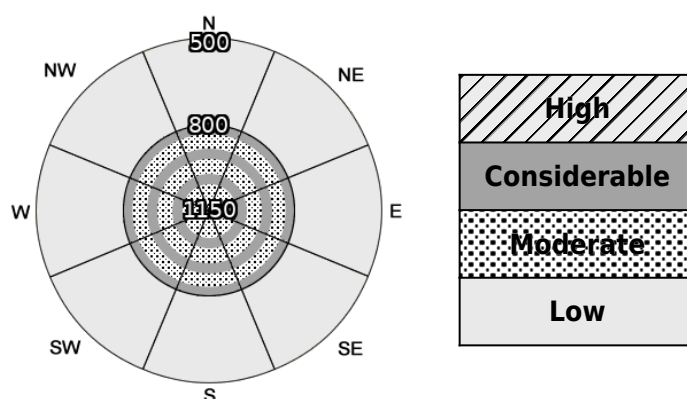

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Loose snow avalanches are likely on steep terrain of all aspects above 800 metres. In many places above 800 metres the top fifty centimetres of the snowpack has some very weak characteristics that at this time do not have critical load. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The forecast is for another cold day with light winds from the East then North-East and the possibility of a snow shower.

Small loose snow avalanches can be large enough to sweep a skier or climber off.
