


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 23/02/2010

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A little drifting will occur and localised accumulations of unstable windslab will form on buried surface hoar on mainly South to Westerly aspects above 950 metres, corrie rims, gully flanks and exits will be especially affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day the wind will be light North-Easterly lessening in strength during the day. Some snowfall may occur. The Freezing level will be at 300 metres.

#### Comments

Current surface hoar layer covering all aspects will present a very weak layer if buried. Use good route finding skills to watch out for these areas.
