

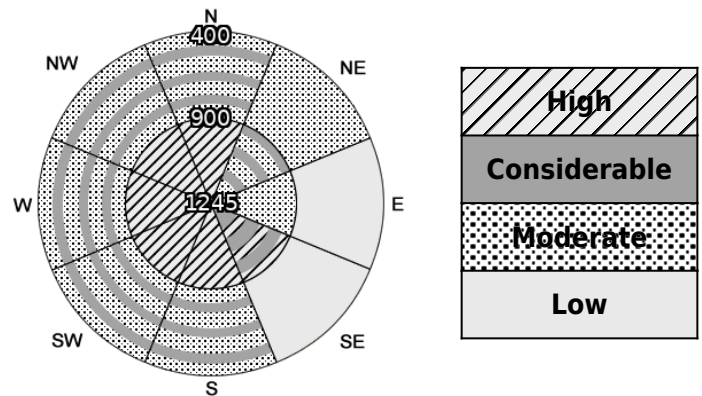
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE HIGH

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 25/02/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will be present on mainly South through West to Northerly aspects above 900 metres where avalanches will occur. Gully exits and flanks in North facing corries will also be affected due to cross loading. Below 900 metres localised unstable accumulations will form in lee areas. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the wind will back strong North-Easterly and this will continue during the day. Heavy snowfall is expected throughout the day with a freezing level of 500 metres.
