

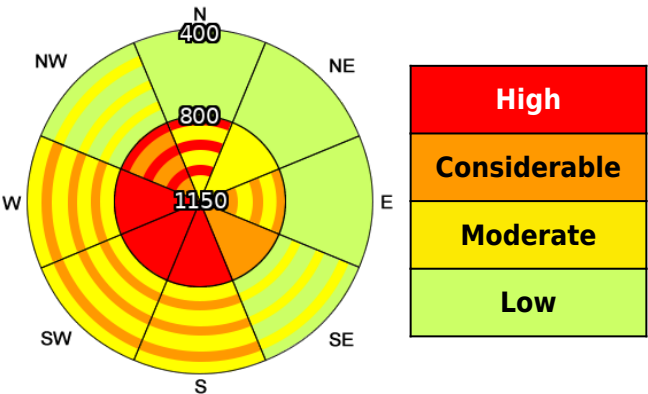

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Windslab will continue to be deposited on mainly South to West aspects, and in other sheltered locations above 800 metres where avalanches will occur. In many places the windslab will overlie a soft and weak layer of buried surface hoar crystals creating a very unstable combination. Any fresh cornices which form will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Outbreaks of snow will continue overnight and through the day. Moderate winds will be from the North-East. The freezing level will be around 500 metres.

Comments

A wild day with low visibility on the tops on Wednesday. Care required in the current avalanche conditions.
