

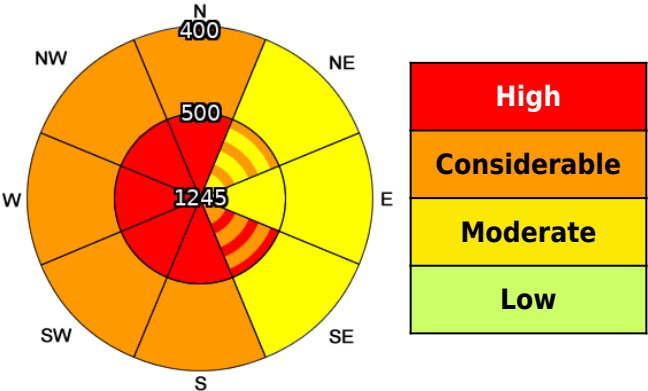

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Very weakly bonded windslab will be present on mainly South through West to Northerly aspects above 500 metres where avalanches will occur. Unstable windslab will also form on other aspects in locations that are sheltered from the wind. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy snowfall will continue overnight with strong East to North-Easterly winds, snowfall will lessen during the day but the wind will remain strong North-Easterly. The freezing level will be at 300 metres.
