

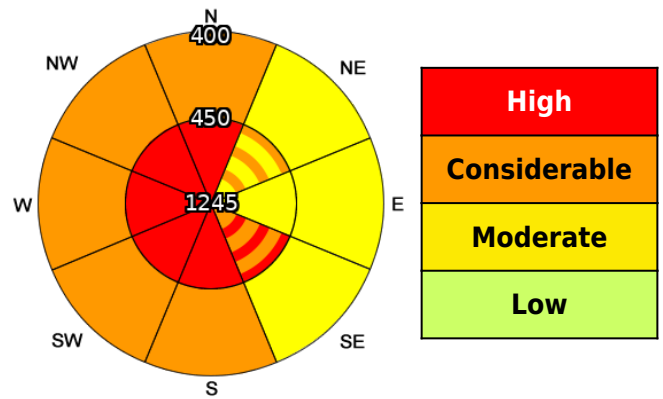

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 27/02/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting will continue especially at higher altitudes. Avalanches will occur mainly on Southerly through West to Northerly aspects above 450 metres. Weakly bonded accumulations will also form on other aspects especially in sheltered locations. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold and snow flurries during Friday night are expected to die out. Strong North-East winds will ease through the day.

Comments

Snowpack unstable careful route choice needed even at low altitudes. Forest areas also a hazard due to weight of snow on branches...(Observer nearly hit by falling branch)
