

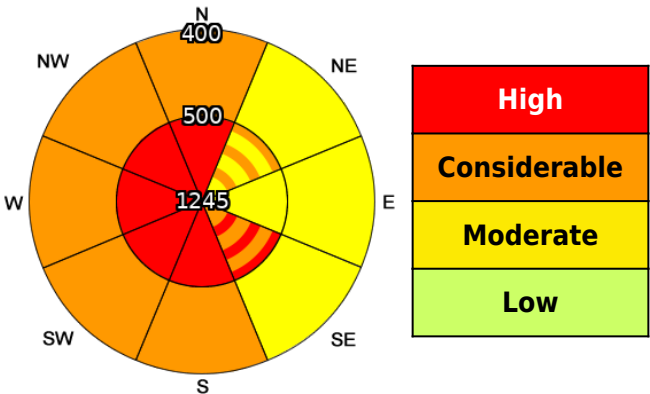

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 28/02/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be drifting at higher altitudes. Weakly bonded windslab will continue to develop. Avalanches will occur mainly on steep Southerly through West to Northerly aspects above 500 metres. Other affected areas will be in sheltered locations such as lee slopes and hollows. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be generally dry with moderate North-East winds and the freezing level will be around 450 metres.
