

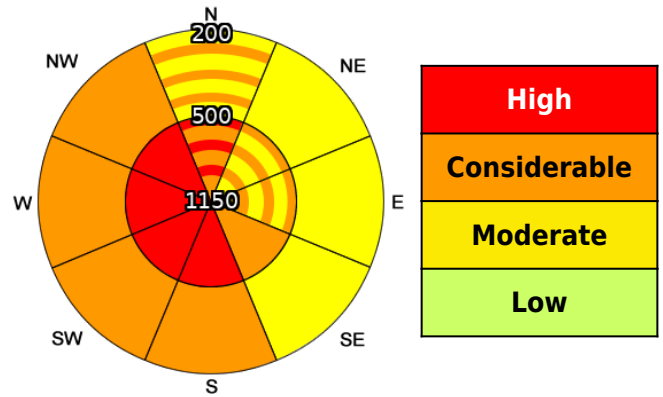
**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE HIGH**

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 28/02/2010**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Further re-distribution of existing snow will take place. Poorly bonded windslab will be present in sheltered gullies and hollows and on mainly South through West to North-West aspects above around 500 metres, where avalanches will occur. More localised areas of poorly bonded windslab will also be present on other aspects and altitudes. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be High.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It is expected to be dry overnight and during the day, with moderate North-Easterly winds. The freezing level will be around 450 metres.

**Comments**

Careful route choice is required in the current conditions.
