

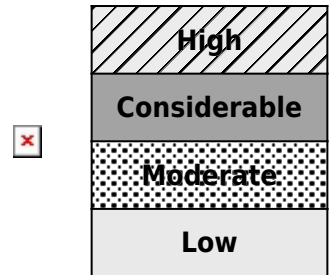
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 02/03/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will persist in the snowpack which underlie windslab, especially on South through West to North aspects above 750 metres where avalanches are likely. Some scouring has taken place on North to East aspects exposing firm snow, but also on these aspects unstable localised windslab will be present. Some stabilisation is taking place at lower levels. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will be dry with moderate North-North-West winds which will ease in the day. Freezing level will be at base levels in the night rising to 400m during the day.

Comments

Poorly bonded windslab on most aspects, good route finding in avalanche terrain required. Human triggered avalanches possible.
