

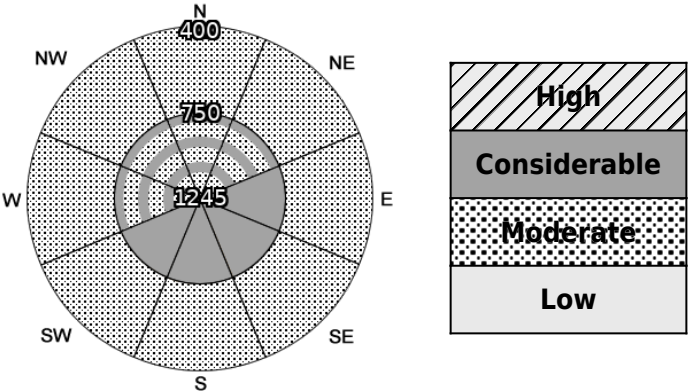

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 05/03/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The extensive weak faceted layer will continue to affect many aspects especially in areas of steep and convex terrain. Drifting will lead to new instabilities and avalanches are likely mainly on steep Easterly through South to South-West aspects above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Significant snowfall will arrive during Thursday night on strong North-North-West winds. This will fall as rain below 700 metres. The freezing level will be around 900 metres.

Comments

The most recent storm windslab appears to be well bonded but worth taking note that it's still overlying the extensive weak faceted layer and could be human triggered.
