

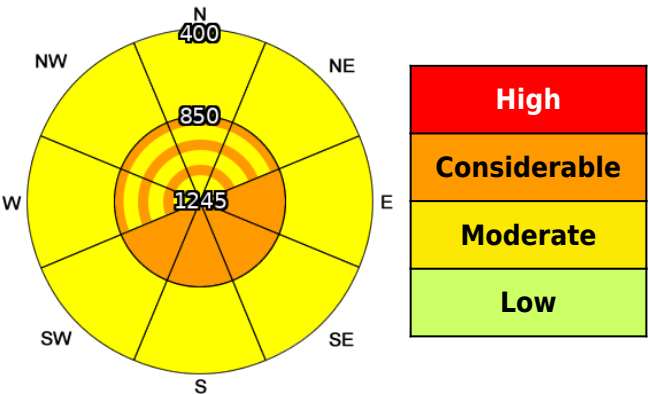

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 06/03/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Windslab accumulations will overlie the extensive weak faceted layer leading to snowpack instabilities. Areas most affected will be on East through South to South-West aspects above 800 metres. Localised weaknesses will continue to affect many other areas especially in steep convex terrain, on scarp slopes, corrie rims and gully flanks. Existing cornices will be prone to collapse in the milder temperatures. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

More settled conditions will arrive as snowfall during Friday night clears to leave a dry day and strong North-North-West winds decrease to moderate. The freezing level will rise up to 1000 metres.
