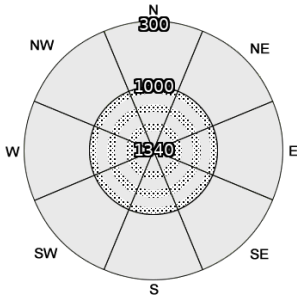


**Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Mon 08/03/2010 TO 18:00HRS Tue 09/03/2010**



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
<b>Very High</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
<b>High</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
<b>Considerable</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
<b>Moderate</b>	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
<b>Low</b>	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Another dry and calm day in prospect with the freezing level gradually rising during the day.

**Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will continue to gradually consolidate at all levels. Localised instabilities will be present on steep slope inclinations on many aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**Observed Weather Influences**

Dry and sunny with a freezing level of around 900m.

**Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack continues to gradually consolidate at all levels. Localised instabilities are present on steep slope inclinations on many aspects. The avalanche hazard is Moderate
