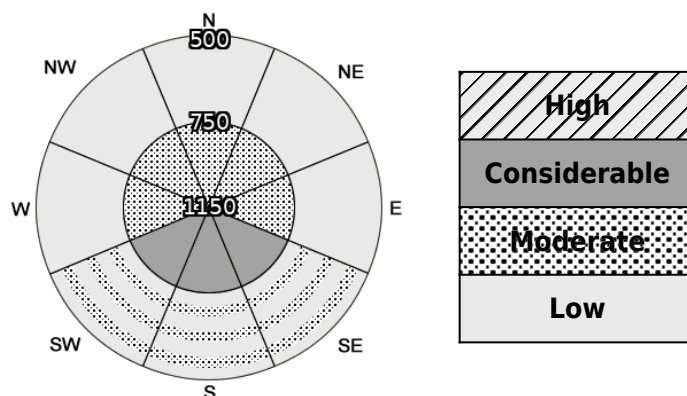


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 09/03/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Surface loose snow instability on steep South aspects above 750 metres will persist. Avalanches are likely where direct radiation affects these slopes. Cornices remain weak, specially on South aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The high pressure weather system influence will prevail. There will be no precipitation and very light variable winds. Daytime warming will be influenced by the amount of cloud cover, with temperatures at 1000 metres rising above freezing in clear afternoon skies.

Comments

Interesting to see firnspegel, not much is known about its avalanche characteristics. The loose snow instability still needs a day or two to settle or run out.
