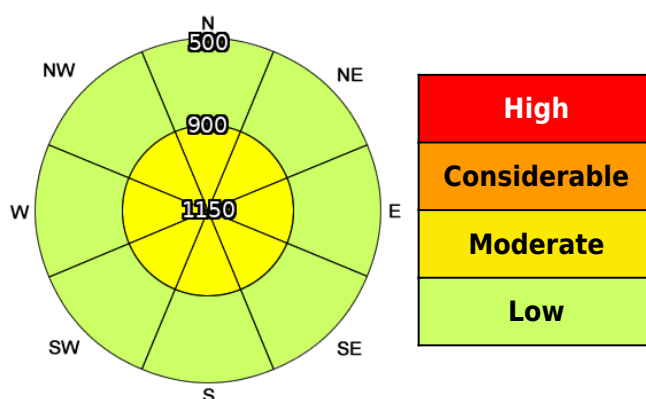


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 11/03/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Localized patches of new windslab will develop on East to South facing slopes mainly above 900 metres. With rising temperatures, cornices and rimed snow clinging to steep rock may become unstable and prone to collapse. Elsewhere the snow will be well bonded and generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Patchy light snow is forecast for Thursday afternoon with the freezing level rising to around 1000 metres. Winds will be strong from the North-West.

Comments

The best conditions on the hill will likely be in the morning due to the approaching front that will track across the region in the afternoon.
